

2: 62°N – Policy – Cookie

To make this Site work properly, we sometimes place small data files called cookies on your device when you visit www.62n.fo.

2.1: What is Cookie

A cookie is a small text file that is placed on your device (e.g. computer or mobile phone) when you visit a website. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, language, font size and other display preferences) over a period of time, so you do not have to keep re-entering them whenever you visit the website page again.

The term cookies includes similar technologies for collecting and storing information, such as Local Shared Objects (commonly referred to as "flash cookies") and web beacons or web bugs (including transparent or clear gifs).

2.2: Cookie type

A cookie can be "session" or "persistent" cookies. They can both be first or third-party cookies. A first-party cookie is set by the website being visited. A third-party cookie is issued by a party other than website being visited.

2.2.1: Session cookies

allow users to be recognized within a website so any page changes or item or data selection you do is remembered from page to page. They are deleted from your device when you close the browser. Read more about [session cookies](#).

2.2.2: Persistent cookies

Help websites remember your information and settings when you visit them in the future. This result in faster and more convenient access since, for example, you do not have to login again. A persistent cookie enables a website to remember you on subsequent visits, speeding up or enhancing your experience of services or functions offered. They will remain stored on your device until deleted or they reach a specified expiry date. Read more about [persistent cookies](#).

2.3: How to control cookies

We use cookies to ensure that we give you the best experience on our website and to allow us to improve our site. By continuing to browse the site without making any changes to your browser settings to restrict or delete cookies you are consenting to our use of cookies in this way.

Browsers can be set to allow you to reject all cookies, or to accept cookies from websites only for the duration of your visit. Some browsers will allow you to reject just third party cookies. If you want to know how to do this please look at the help menu on your browser. Please be aware that if you choose to delete or restrict cookies some features of this website may not work.

2.4: How we use cookies

We use cookies for the following purposes:

- Navigation assistance for you on our website

2.4.1: Cookie Privacy setting

Information may be retrieved or stored on your browser in cookies by visiting our or any website. It can not identify you directly.

2.4.2: Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are necessary for the function of the website and to allow access to use its features. Typical only set in response to action made by you to request for services, e.g. logging or filling in forms. Personal identifiable information are not stored by these cookies.

2.4.3: Analytical/performance cookies

These cookies monitor how users accessed the website and collect anonymous information. All collected information is aggregated and anonymous, also helpful for us on what features on the website work and what could be improved. Please allow these cookies, otherwise we might not be able to provide a full service, based on no website visit monitoring by the performance cookie.

2.4.4: Personalisation cookies

Personalisation cookies help to recognize re-visits to our website and to record your page visit browsing history.

2.4.5: Cookie security and privacy

2.4.6: Functionality cookies

These cookies recognise you if you re-visit our website, record information about choices you have made. This enables us to make a more personal content for you, greet you by name and remember your choices and preferences.

2.4.7: Targeting cookies

These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed and information from IP addresses. These cookies will be used to make our website more relevant to you and your interests.

We may use third party service providers to perform these services for us and when this is the case the cookies may be set by third party with our permission. The third party service providers may share information with other parties. These cookies are not controlled by 62°N. The third party cookies are identified in the detailed list.

2.5: Embedded content

Sometimes we embed images, videos or other content from third party websites. As a result when you visit the page featuring this content you may be presented with cookies from these websites. We do not control these cookies and cannot prevent these sites or domains from collecting information on your use of this content. You should check the relevant party's website for more information.

2.6: Social networking and sharing tools

On some pages we may feature embedded share buttons or widgets that allow you to share content with friends through a number of social networking sites. These social

networking sites may set cookies that can identify you as an individual when you are also logged into their services. We do not control these cookies and you should check with the relevant website to see how your information is used.

The table below details the most frequently used cookies on www.62n.fo and explains their use. We will keep our cookies list as up to date as possible.

__hstc	3rd	Targeting cookies.	HubSpot Analytics. Cookie name is associated with websites built on the HubSpot platform. It is reported by them as being used for website analytics. The main cookie for tracking visitors. ASP.NET_SessionId	1st	Session cookies.	General purpose platform session cookie, used by sites written with Microsoft .NET based technologies. Usually used to maintain an anonymised user session by the server. This cookie is used to make to site function when you move around the site.	Automatically by closing browser
